Things to know before starting your application

1.USE A LAPTOP OR PC

We strongly suggest not filling out the application form from your smartphone. Qualtrics is best accessed through a laptop or PC. While your progress may be saved in qualtrics, it is still possible you'll lose your progress if you leave the application and come back. It is best to complete the application all at once!



2.HAVE YOUR ESSAY PREPARED

Inside the application, you will be prompted to upload a 250 word minimum essay. This is best formatted as a PDF or Word doc. - Describe how your experiences in 4-H projects have influenced your future career goals. Include specific examples of skills or insights you've gained through 4-H and explain how this class will help you further develop those skills to prepare for your future. Your response should connect your 4-H experiences, career ambitions, and the ways you think this class will support your journey toward those goals.

3.PERSONAL INFORMATION NEEDS

Have your personal, 4-H and high school information ready prior to filling out the application. You will need: high school and high school counselor name, county name, extension agent name. - These contacts will also need to complete required signatures forms in a separate qualtrics link.



4. REVIEW COURSES OFFERED

In the application, you will be asked to rank your most to least preferred course to enroll in. We want everyone to have the opportunity to get one of their top picks. Each class is limited to 20 participants, so this will help us place everyone without overflow. Please review course descriptions so you're confident in what course selection to make.
