## **Annual Qualified Exemption Review (2024)**



## FSMA Produce Safety Rule Reference § 112.7

To be eligible for a qualified exemption your farm must meet two requirements: 1) farm must have food sales averaging less than \$500,000 per year, adjusted<sup>5</sup> for inflation, during the previous three years; and 2) the farm sales to qualified endusers<sup>2</sup> must exceed sales to all others combined during the previous three years.

A farm with a qualified exemption MUST still meet the following two modified requirements: 1) disclosing the name and the complete business<sup>3</sup> address of the farm where the produce was grown; and 2) maintaining records<sup>4</sup> to prove that you meet this qualified exemption. Completing this worksheet is one way to maintain these records.

<sup>2</sup> A qualified end-user is either (a) the consumer of the food or (b) a restaurant or retail food establishment that is located in the same state as the farm or not more than 275 miles away. Sales through a broker are not qualified end users. The term consumer does not apply to a business.

<sup>3</sup> Modified labeling requirement - Include the name and complete business address either on the label of the produce (if a label is required under the FD&C Act) or display the same information at the point of purchase (through a sign, label, placard, etc).

<sup>4</sup> Complete and sign this or similar worksheet annually. Keep the records on file in case you are asked to provide them.
