



About This Role:

Cowley County Extension in partnership with K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems is seeking a Local Food Fellow to complete the local food system project: **Kitchen Incubator and Food Preservation.**

This full-time for 8 weeks or part-time for 10-12 weeks, fellowship will run from ~June 2, 2025 ~ August 23, 2025.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in incubator kitchen development to include researching existing kitchens and surveying potential users.
- Compile/develop incubator operating policies and procedures into a complete operations manual.
- · Recruit kitchen users.
- Promote value-added food options.
- Coordinate and assist with food preservation and recovery education including helping acquire produce and assist with workshop content.
- Develop consumer educational materials and graphics about the benefits of local food systems.
- Complete final report to be submitted to K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems Program Coordinator before finishing fellowship time period.
