



About This Role and Organization:	Full Circle Sustainability, in partnership with K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems, is seeking a Local Food Fellow to help market Full Circle and develop content related to local food to share with our community. Full Circle is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit devoted to making low-waste living easier through creating more sustainable systems, including increasing access to local food and low-waste home and grocery items. We do that through our retail shop and home delivery service as well as by providing information to the public about issues related to local food and sustainability.
Responsibilities:	This part-time, 16-week fellowship will run from February to May 2025.
	 In collaboration with Full Circle's Executive and Operations Directors, create and implement a strategy for promoting Full Circle to the community. Develop and distribute marketing materials. Write press releases and pitch stories to appropriate news outlets. Develop content around the benefits of local food to use on the Full Circle website, Facebook page, blog, newsletter, and in the shop. Develop content that highlights Full Circle's partner producers, including written producer profiles, photos and short video clips from the farms, and longer interviews with farmers. Interview customers individually and as part of a focus group to identify messages that resonate and determine what types of communication and marketing efforts will be effective. Utilize feedback from customers as well as additional research and outside knowledge to help craft narratives about Full Circle that will speak to different audiences. Create short interview clips with customers talking about Full Circle and their reasons for supporting local agriculture. Reach out to and connect with other groups doing work related to local food and sustainability. Complete final report to be submitted to K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems Program Coordinator before the end of the fellowship period.
Location:	This is a hybrid remote and in-person position located in Topeka, Kansas. The job will require some travel within northeast Kansas to visit our partner farms.
Why Join Us:	Join us on our mission to increase access to local food in Topeka and help share information on the benefits of sustainable agriculture with our community! As a Local Food Fellow, you will be promoting Full Circle so that we can increase the number of consumers and producers we serve. And you will be helping develop content around local food to educate Topekans about why they should shop and eat locally and sustainably.
