This part-time, 320-hour fellowship will occur between March 24 – August 8, 2025. Timing is flexible based on the needs of the selected candidate.

Location:

This is a remote position.

Responsibilities:

- Create marketing materials for the 2025 Kansas Local Food Summit including press release, print flyers, social media posts, and graphic design.
- Support writing Local Foods Newsletter.
- Support summit logistics by attending and working the summit in summer 2025.
- Work with staff to create educational publications on local food system benefits.
- Support end of grant reporting including storytelling and summary writing.
- Work on your own creative local food marketing idea.
- Complete final report to be submitted to K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems Program Coordinator before finishing fellowship time period.
