



About This Role:

Pittsburg Farmers' Market, in partnership with K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems, is seeking a Local Food Fellow to complete the local food system project: Social Media Manager/Market Manager Assistant

This part-time, approximately 20 hours per week, sixteen-week fellowship will run from April 14th through August 1st, 2025.

Responsibilities:

- Promote the market through social media and other outlets to increase awareness.
- Conduct "Vendor Spotlight" interviews on an approved timeline. Visit vendor properties, create video or written stories with pictures detailing what each vendor sells and how they create their products.
- Maintain positive relationships with all vendors.
- Attend and assume the "Market Manager" position on certain Saturday mornings from June through July. This entails unlocking and setting up the market facilities, ensuring vendor well-being, submitting SNAP/EBT transactions and collecting vendor fees.
- Assist Market Manager, when applicable, in advertising for, securing, and maintaining local sponsorships.
- Promote use of nutrition purchasing programs such as SNAP/EBT & Senior Farmers' Market.
- Conduct customer, potential customer, and vendor surveys.
- Perform related functions as assigned.
- Complete final report to be submitted to K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems Program Coordinator before finishing fellowship time period.
