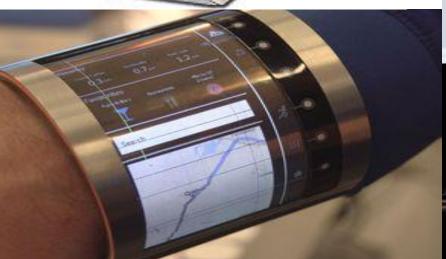

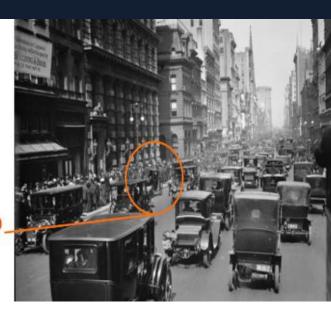

Understanding the Public: Cognitive Biases

Confirmation Bias – we agree with people who agree with us – Google

In-group Bias – we agree with people in our tribe (love insiders, suspicious of outsiders)

Gamblers Fallacy – overweighing previous events as predicting future outcomes – Coin Toss

Ownership Bias – we value more what we already possess – The Ticket Paradox

Neglecting Probability – ignoring scientific probability in favour of irrational fears – Flying, Driving, and Terrorism

Observational Selection Bias – suddenly noticing something and believing its frequency has increased – Jeep and Pregnant Women

Status-Quo Bias – make choices to keep things the same, fear different choices mean change -Relationships Negativity Bias – pay attention and give more weight to bad news as an old survival instinct – Reacting to the Noise in the Bush

Bandwagon Effect – group think, opinion polls, town hall meetings – Fit In and Win

Projection Bias – we assume others are like us – good or bad – Trusting and Cheats

The Current Moment
Bias – living in the
present and move
pleasure to now, pain to
later – Savings and a
Donut

Anchoring Effect –
places us in a position
and we move relatively
from that anchor – Start
the Bidding

Post-purchase Rationalization – stems from the principal of commitment - TV

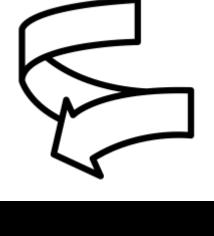
