USDA Rural Development Program Areas

USDA Rural Development has Three Program Areas:

- **Housing Programs:** Through the Housing Programs, USDA Rural Development offers programs for homeownership, home repair and rehabilitation, affordable housing preservation, rental assistance, and Multi-Family housing assistance.
- Community Programs: Through the Community Programs USDA Rural Development assists rural communities, municipalities, non-profits, schools, libraries, first responders, healthcare organizations and other entities with loan and grant programs. The agency also finances water and wastewater treatment facilities, rural broadband, distance learning, and electric services, among others.
- Business and Cooperative Programs: Through the Business and Cooperative Programs, USDA Rural Development provides loans, loan guarantees, and grants to assist Maine businesses and economic development organizations. Programs include renewable energy, value-added producer grants, revolving loan funds, and more.
